Oceania HOA - Masters Requirements And Age Clarification

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Following the adoption of World Skate international age grades for the 2018/19 Skating year, the Artistic Committee will be adopting the World Skate Age Requirement Rule. This will replace the current Age Rule (4.00.02) in the NZ Rules and Regulations document.

The new age rule is as follows:

Skaters shall be graded according to the age they are turning in the year of competition (that is, in the calendar year being; 1st January through to and including the 31st of December, in the year of competition)

Additionally, the following clause shall be added:

To be eligible to compete in any category, a skater who has competed in international competition in the previous year in a higher category must not compete in a lower one in the following year.

REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTERS AND ADVANCED MASTERS GRADES

The following requirements have been set for the 2018/19 skating year:

Masters Solo Dance

Compulsory Dance: Double Cross Waltz.

Style Dance: Pattern - Canasta Tango / 2.00 +- 10 sec / Spanish Medley / Footwork - diagonal maximum level 1

Masters Couples Dance

Compulsory Dance: Double Cross Waltz.

Style Dance: Pattern - Canasta Tango / 2.00 +-10 sec / Spanish Medley / Hold Sequence - diagonal maximum level 1.

Advanced Masters Solo Dance

Compulsory Dance: Fourteen Step (ladies steps).

Freedance: 2.30 +- 10 sec. / Circular Step Sequence - clockwise, maximum level 2 / Straight Line Step Sequence - diagonal maximum level 2 / OPTIONAL jump and/or spin

Advance Master Couples Dance

Compulsory Dance: Fourteen Step.

Style Dance: Pattern - Metropolitan Tango / 2.00 +- 10 sec. / Spanish medley / Hold Sequence - diagonal maximum level 2 / OPTIONAL stationary lift.
