#### 2020-2021 PRESIDENT'S ANNUAL REPORT - Tabled at the AGM 25th May 2021

Welcome to all.

I wish to thank all of the Committee, Skaters, Coaches, members, and supporters for their support of the Club over the past year, and I'd like to welcome all our new members.

We've had quite an interesting year this year! At our last AGM we were just starting to come out of our level 4 restrictions and it was a very uncertain time for everyone. It was great to see our coaches and our club members supporting each other with online coaching sessions, videos and zoom chats, and that club spirit carried on through to the lower levels of lockdown and beyond! When we were able to get back into the rink everyone came back with a hiss and a roar, including a lot of the public who had found roller skating on the internet. Our membership, disco and patch attendance have all increased this year.

While it was disappointing to not have a National Championship, Oceania Championship or World Championship last year we were able to have a couple of competitions with an Area Open and our Club Champs. So far in 2021 we've had our Upper Hutt Open, Central Area Champs and, just this last weekend – Laurie Hastie in Palmerston North. I'd like to extend a big congratulations to all of our coaches and skaters for getting out there and doing us all proud. I hope you are all celebrating your successes, training hard and looking forward to NZ Champs in July.

Congratulations also go to all of our Officials and Coaches who have who have gained commissions during the last year. Our Club Officials have helped not only at our Club but at competitions and medal tests throughout NZ. Thank you, it is very much appreciated.

We have had a lot of up-skilling happening within the club over the past year and I would like to congratulate Imelda Coleman and Emma Patrick who have gained Technical Specialist Accreditations, and Jess Hare and Julia Moore who both passed their DEO Theory exams and will have sat their practical exam over the weekend (we don't have results yet though).

We also have a good group of Data Entry and judge trainees within the club and it's great to see so many stepping forward to take on an official role.

Upper Hutt has been a big driving force in the deployment of RollArt in New Zealand over the past few years and I'd like to take a moment to acknowledge a few people who have put a lot of work into this.

Raewyn Hailes is not only a senior judge and referee but is also part of the national Roll Art steering committee and has put many hours of effort into supporting the education of New Zealand Officials. She has also been instrumental in the development and administration of new official's accreditations.

Bruce Crosby and Raynor Stratford were both quick to take up the challenge of learning how to administer the new Roll Art software, run events and perform the Data Entry Operator role. These two have been quietly working away behind the scenes to produce training material to be used nationally, and run training sessions with new and existing officials.

The Club is always looking for new Officials to assist within the sport so if you are interested in any role or helping in any way please let the committee know.

Another person who has dedicated much of their time to the sport of Roller Skating in New Zealand is our long-time club member Roger Boulcott. At the NZFRS AGM last year he stepped down as President of the Federation after many years of service firstly as a board member and for the last few years as President. I'm not sure that everyone is aware of the sheer amount of work that he has done supporting our sport within this country and internationally. His role encompasses not only artistic roller skating, but speed, inline and rink hockey and in recent years, skateboarding, scootering and roller derby. I'd like everyone to please give Roger a big hand in appreciation of all he has achieved.

On behalf of the Club I wish to thank our Patch Class Head Coaches; Katelyn Kennedy, Imelda Coleman and all of their helpers. Since lockdown our Patch Classes have been busier than ever and the coaches have all been doing a wonderful job. Thanks also to Angie Munn and Sarah Healey our Patch Class Managers. Along with their Assistants, they have done a marvellous job of looking after the Admin side of our Patch classes. They keep everything running smoothly and it's really appreciated.

I'd also like to thank our club coaches who work with our skaters every week here at the rink and provide valuable support at our learn to skate classes, skate camps and training events. I would like to congratulate Abi Evans, Terriann Randle and Kotuku Ruki who have all stepped up to the challenge and gained an SSL1 coaching accreditation this year. Katelyn Kennedy has had a bumper coaching year too, taking up a position alongside Imelda Coleman on the New Zealand Academy of Coaches. She has also gained Level 2 Sports Specific coaching accreditations. Well done, Katelyn!

Our Public discos on Saturday's and School Holidays have been going really well this year with ever increasing attendance and more and more people arriving with their own skates. It's great to see so many of the public investing in this sport, hopefully they have found a life-long hobby. While the discos are going strongly we have had a harder and harder time finding volunteers to staff the disco's so the club has changed to a new "opt-in" system where club members are credited for the time that they spend helping out. This system has been championed by our Disco Co-Ordinator Helen Nicol, who has also been doing a wonderful job of keeping the disco's running smoothly. Income from these sessions helps to pay for the rental of the rink and other outgoings we have, plus they help to keep your rink fees at a reasonable level. I encourage you all to "Opt-in" and join what I am sure will be a fun and friendly Disco team.

Private bookings on weekdays and Saturday evenings have also been very popular. Thank you to Megan who co-ordinates our private bookings and to everyone who assists with these bookings.

Remutaka Roller Derby League and Rimutaka Inline Hockey Club have continued to book the rink on a regular basis. I would like to thank these groups for choosing to use our facility.

This is a bittersweet AGM for me this year as it will be my last year as president. It was quite a learning curve when Bruce asked me to step into the secretary role back in 2016 and it's all been one big whirlwind since. There have been many challenges but also so much support and friendship from the other members of this wonderful club.
